Graduation qualifications from this department

Compulsory courses: 81 credits (including 53 credits of compulsory courses, 6 credits of English and 22 credits of general studies)

Electives: 47 credits (including 29 credits of departmental electives, 9 compulsory credits, and 9 credits of cross-department experience microcredits from external departments, but does not include general education, physical education, and military training courses)

Compulsory elective courses: defined as those that need to take the course within the study period (the second withdrawal during the semester will be deemed as no study), and the transcript has the score of the subject, and it can be listed in the department's major electives. and meet graduation qualifications.

Before graduation, students must (1) complete a credit course participated by the department or (2) study a certificate training course offered by the college or department with passing grades, and obtain the certificate

corresponding to the course.

Among the credit-bearing courses in which this department participates, courses offered by external departments can be recognized as 9 credits of elective courses taken by external departments.

Minimum credits for graduation: 128 credits

Common compulsory notes for schools and colleges

- 1. The study of English and multiple general education courses for students in this department must be based on the "Key Points for English Courses, On-Campus and Off-Campus Certification Examinations and "Workplace English" Coursework" and "Regulations on General Education Courses of Chung Hwa University" during the study period 1, only after completing the required academic credits can you meet the graduation qualifications.
- 2. Students studying physical education courses in this department must complete the required credits within the study period in accordance with the "Regulations on Physical Education Courses of Chung Hwa University" to be eligible for graduation.
- 3. Must meet the "Implementation Measures for the Graduation Qualification Test of English Proficiency of Chinese University Students" and the "Key Points of the Student Information Application Ability Test TQC Certificate Award".
- Students of the School of Management must pass the TOC Excel Practical Level, MOS Excel Standard Level or the Excel Information Application Ability Test administered by the school. They can choose one.
- 4. Students out the school of Management must pass the TQC excer Fractical Level, MOS excer standard Level of the excer information Points for Promoting Volunteer Campus Culture of Chung Hwa University" to be eligible for graduation.
- 5. Students must complete the study regulations in accordance with the "Implementation Measures for the Basic Ability Indicators of Students of the Chung Hua University", "Implementation Measures of the Basic Ability Indicators of Students of the Chung Hua University", and "Implementation Measures of the Basic Ability Indicators of Students of the Department of Information Management of the Chung Hua University" to be eligible for graduation.
- 6. In order to allow Chung Hua University students to understand the curriculum characteristics of various colleges in the university in their freshman year, and to start a cross-field teaching concept when they reach the freshman stage, students of our school must take the "Cross-College Experience Micro Credit Course" in their freshman year.
- 7. In order to achieve the "communication and expression ability" in the basic competency index of Chung Hua University students, students in this department must complete and pass the English proficiency test within the period of study in accordance with the "Implementation Measures for the Graduation Qualification Test of English Proficiency of Students of Chung Hua University", and based on "Key Points for the Implementation of the Chinese Proficiency Test of Chung Hwa University",

Only students who have completed and passed the Chinese proficiency test are eligible for graduation.

- 8. In order to achieve the "healthy physical ability" in the basic competency index of Chung Hua University students, students in this department must complete the required study credits and pass the swimming ability test and physical examination within the period of study in accordance with the "Chinese University Physical Education Course Course Procedures". Only after passing the fitness test will you be eligible for graduation.
- 9. According to the "Implementation Measures of Innovation and Creativity Courses of Chung Hua University", those who pass the inspection standards must pass the "Creative Thinking and Innovation Management" and "Graduation Topic (1) (2)" innovative and creative courses to meet the graduation qualifications.
